Quilt Contest Rules

Please Read Carefully

1. Open to all, but must be the work of the person or group applying to the competition. Limit of 2 entries per person or group. Family members/permanent employees of show management or sponsors are not eligible. Quilts must be constructed and quilted by person(s) named on entry blank.
2. Quilts and wall quilts only. Entry must be quilted either by hand or machine. No kits or tied quilts. **Quilts must be greater than or equal to 1900 square inches. Wall quilts are defined as quilts less than 1900 square inches but more than 576 square inches.** There is no maximum size for quilt entries.
3. Quilts winning cash at Mid-Atlantic Quilt Festival, Denver National Quilt Festival, World Quilt Show-New England, Pennsylvania National Quilt Extravaganza or Pacific International Quilt Festival are not eligible to be judged.
4. Entries must have been finished in 2008, 2009 or 2010 and be in excellent condition.
5. Amateur entries are defined as entries created by persons who have never taught quilting for a fee, published books on the subject of quilting, made money from their quilting through selling, designing or stitching, or won prize monies at a quilt competition. *Note:* Group quilts are not eligible for amateur entry status.
6. Entry must have a 4" sleeve casing for hanging as well as a cloth label with the name, address and telephone number of the entrant securely sewn to the back.
7. Ship the entry in a secure carton. Place the item in a sturdy plastic bag. *Do not use Styrofoam or cellulose packing products of any kind.* Cost of return shipping and insurance in return transit will be the responsibility of PIQF. Original carton will be used to return the item via UPS or other designated carrier. Please remove all old shipping labels from the carton prior to shipping.
8. Entries must be available for display at Pacific International Quilt Festival, October 14-17, 2010, at the Santa Clara Convention Center, Santa Clara, California.
9. If a quilt is to be hand-delivered to the festival and/or personally picked up from the festival, show management must be notified in writing prior to September 24, 2010.
10. If the quilt is to be returned shipped to an address other than the one listed on this form, show management must be notified in writing of the change prior to September 24, 2010. All foreign entries must be returned to their point of origin.
11. If accepted, slides/digital images and photographs taken become the property of PIQF for publicity and/or publication use.
12. Prize winners will be notified within ten (10) business days. Viewers' Choice will be presented at the Show & Tell event on Saturday, October 16, 2010.
13. The awarding of any prize makes the entry ineligible for any lesser prize. Viewer's Choice award is exempt from this rule.
14. Filing of your signed application signifies agreement with these conditions.

To Enter - Send:

- A. Completed entry form with a non-refundable entry fee of \$20.00 per quilt. **IMPORTANT:** Please make check payable to Mancuso Show Management.
- B. Two color slides or digital images (full view and close-up) submitted on a CD. Identify each slide or CD with your name and title of quilt. CDs and slides will not be returned.
- C. **IMPORTANT:** A business-size, #10, Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope (44 cents postage).

Quilt Return

Quilts will be returned via PIQF designated carrier only and shipped within 48 hours of close of the Festival. Cost of the shipping will be paid by PIQF. Items will be insured for \$1,000 US each on return shipping. Management reserves the right to delay the return shipment of winning entries for up to ten business days for the purposes of professional photography.

Important Note: Foreign entries **MUST** be shipped to the event via the PIQF designated carrier only. (Complete information will follow upon acceptance.)
